

## Activity programme for children

Children's creche sessions are staffed by support teachers and nursery nurses from the Sensory Support Service.



The activities are designed to meet the very individual needs of the following groups of children:

### Monday morning: Bubbles

This is our introductory group for babies and younger children and is a sensory support service session.

### Tuesday morning: Explorers

Explorers is our group for children with a vision impairment and is a Look West parent resource.

### Friday morning: Achievers

Friday's group is for children who are multi-needs sensory impaired and is a sensory support service session.
