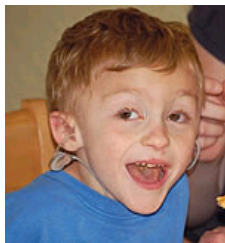


## Support this year's Sense Holiday Appeal

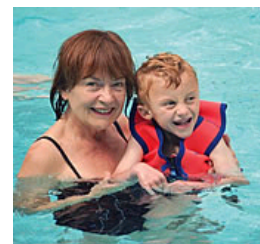
