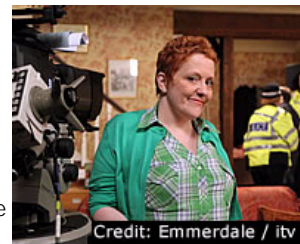


## Soap star runs for Sense!
